

THE BIODIVERSITY EXHIBITION

In Biodiversity Park there is a place where visitors can learn about the history of biodiversity and agriculture, the importance of agricultural biodiversity and the species and ecosystems that are a rich resource of and for the planet: the Biodiversity Exhibition.

The exhibition consists of eight main spaces in a circular layout, in addition to an area, curated by the Italian Ministry of the Environment, where multimedia presentations accompany tangible experiences. The cylinder shape is a recurring element of the exhibition, to conserve and showcase Italy's natural heritage and agricultural wealth, while also planting questions in the minds of the visitors to aid their comprehension of the true sense of the theme "*Feed the Planet. Energy for Life*".

Visitors will enter the first section, the Introduction, where they can decide if they want to proceed in a clockwise direction (travelling from the past towards the future) or if they prefer to move in an anti-clockwise direction (from the future towards the past).
