

Camst Group: "plastic free" restaurant and catering for SANA 2019

Bologna, 3 September 2019

For SANA 2019, the Camst Group, which manages catering services at the Bologna Exhibition Centre will be providing a completely "plastic free" service in the bars, cafes and canteens open to the public, as well as the catering service for exhibitors.

With a ban on single use plastic, plates, cups, straws and salad bowls will all be made exclusively from biodegradable material, while paper napkins will be made from recycled paper.

Plastic water bottles or containers will not be on sale.

Visitors will be able to purchase water or flavoured drinks (citrus, aloe and stevia; blueberry, aloe and stevia; pomegranate, orange, lemon and ginger; water melon, apple, grape and turmeric; grape, blueberry, pomegranate, cinnamon and coconut) from special distributors positioned at the refreshment points. Visitors to Sana, furthermore, will be able to purchase 500ml stainless steel double-wall thermos flasks with screw tops at a discounted price. Small bottles of natural water will also be on sale in bottles made of biodegradable material.

Furthermore, as a contribution to further raise awareness of this particular issue, all refreshment points will display some humorous cartoons on the topic of "plastic free" by Bologna's own Zap&lda.

Concerning the food and beverage offer, in the bars, cafes and catering services, the emphasis will be on healthy and sustainable snacks, sandwiches, pastries, pizzas, fruit and drinks, including wines, all of which will be rigorously organic.
